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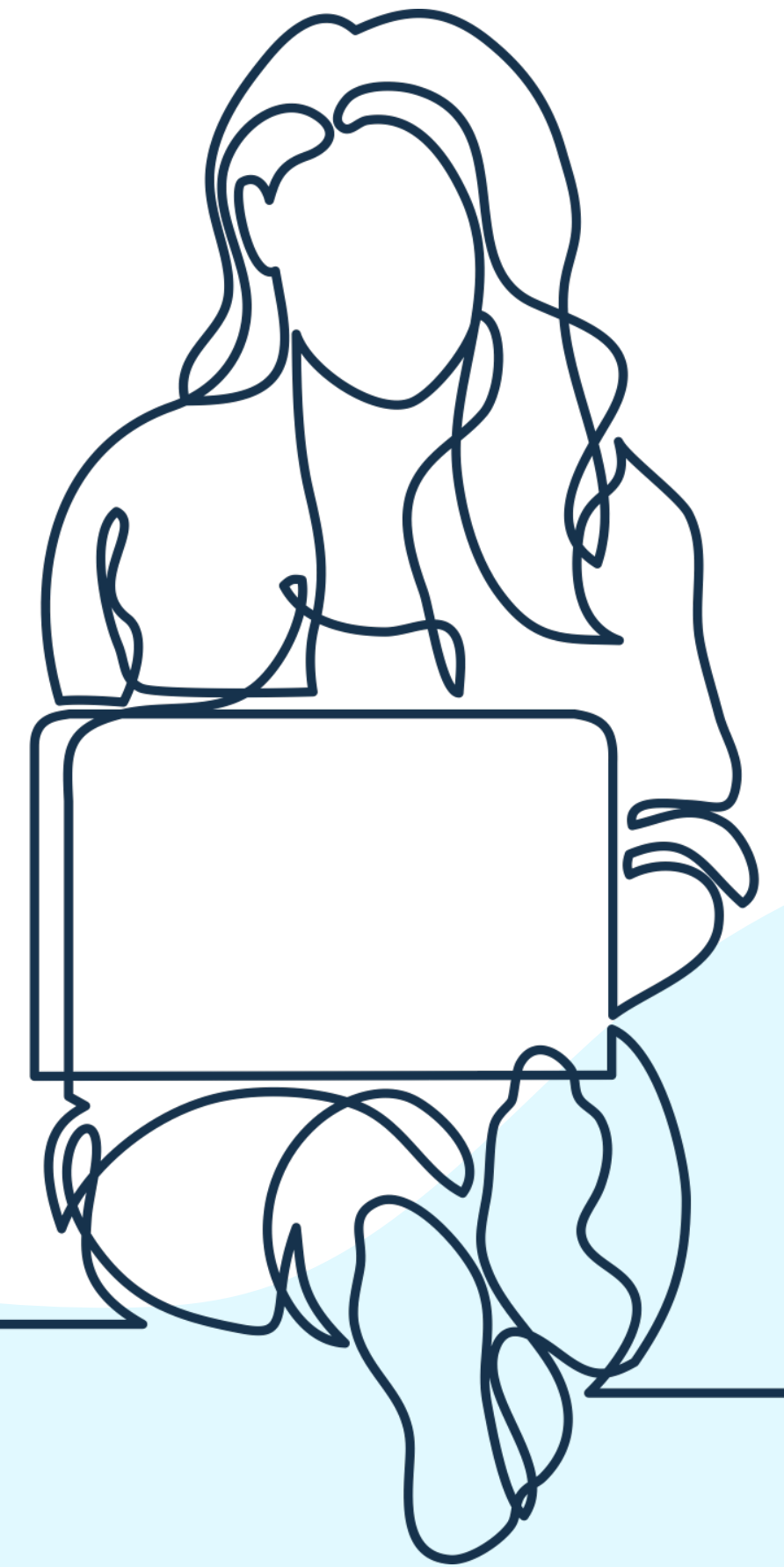


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EUROSTUDENT collects comparable microdata on the social dimension of European higher education.

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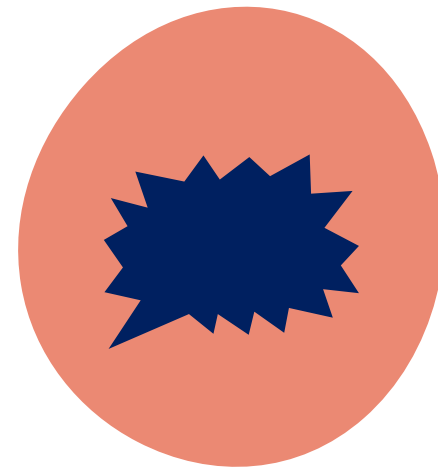

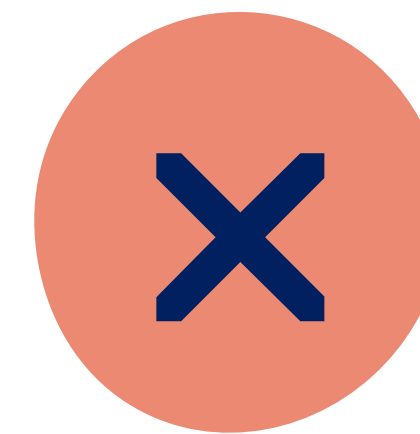

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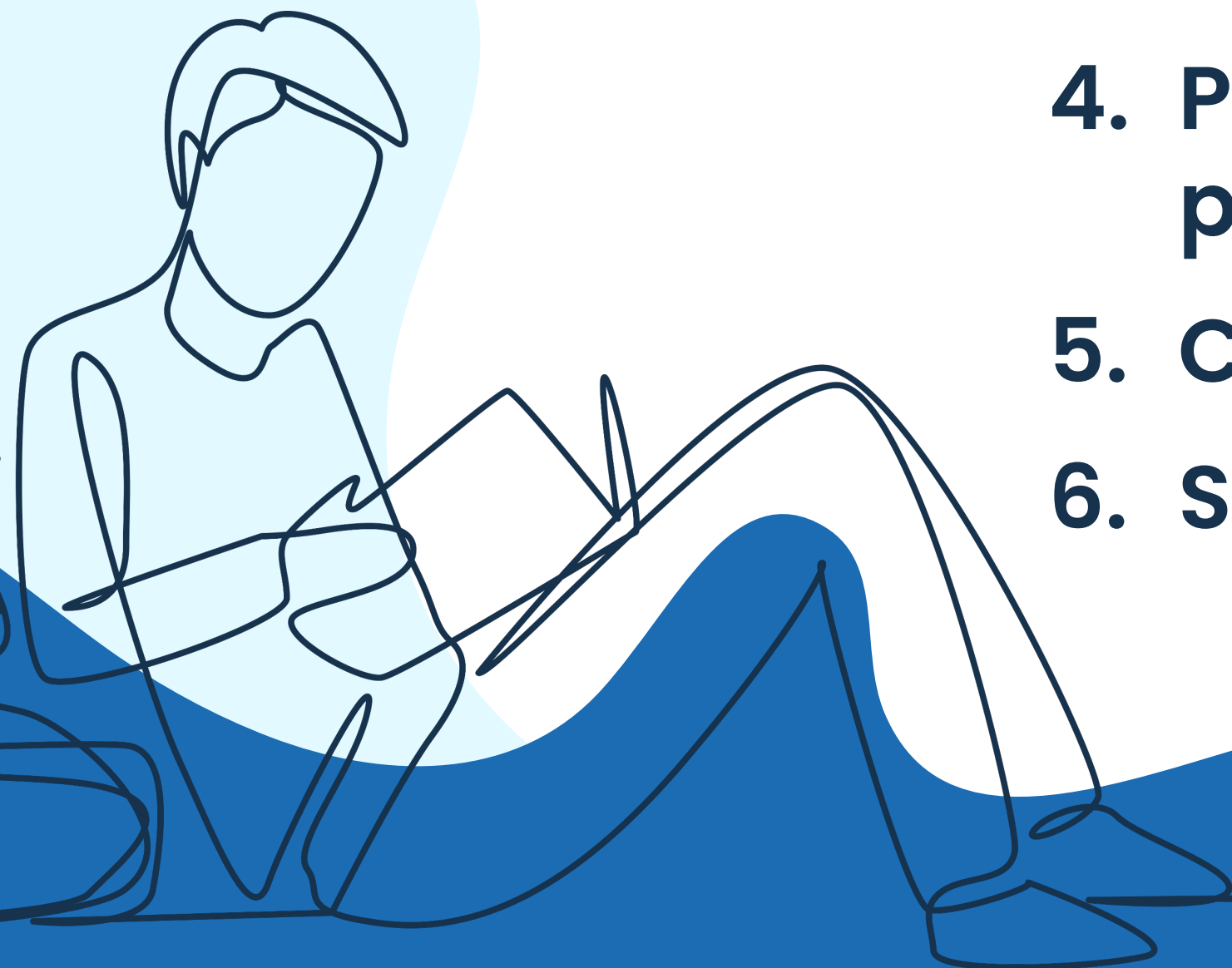
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HOW?

6. SUBMIT



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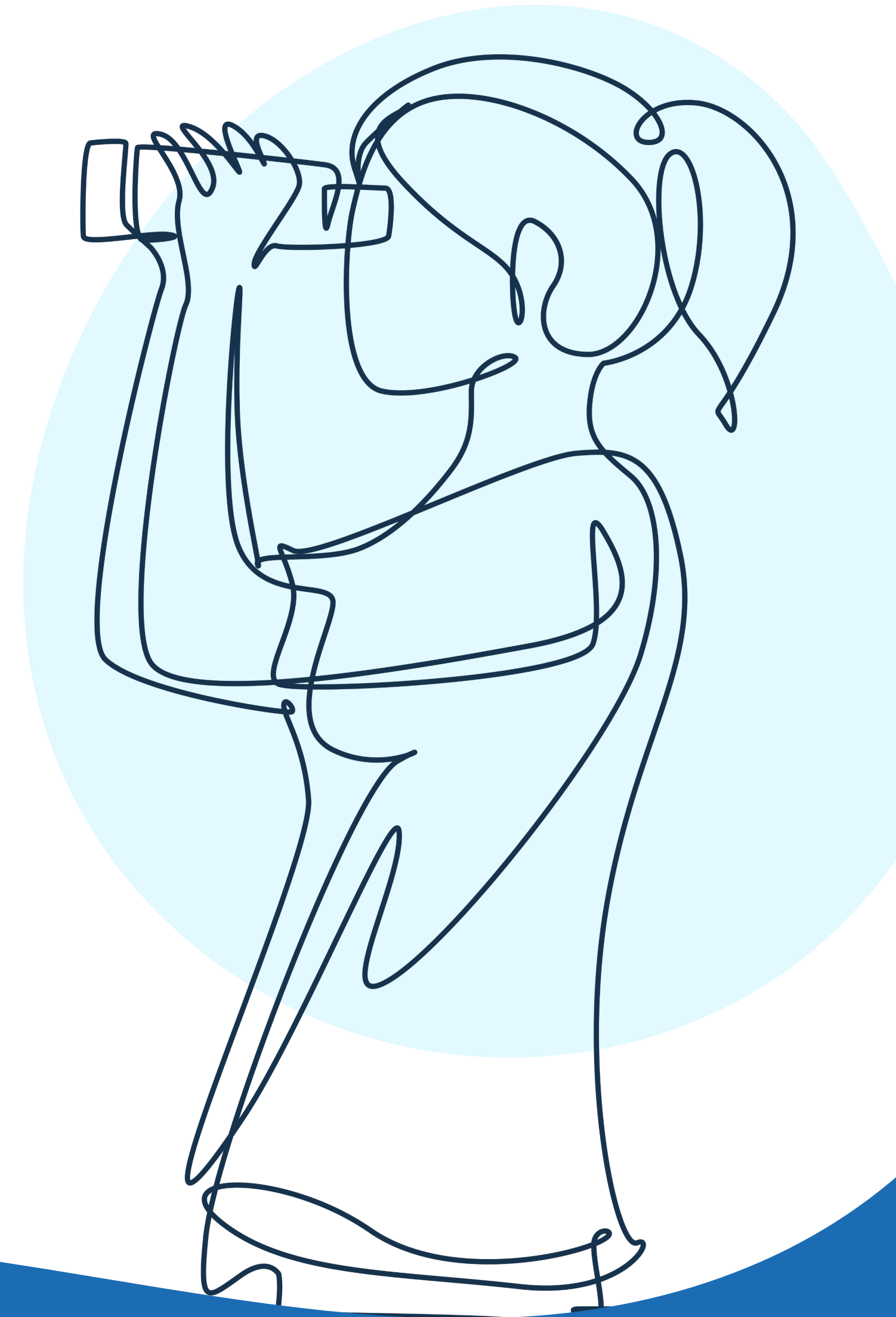

- **With exploratory factor analysis we looked how these are connected to each other.**

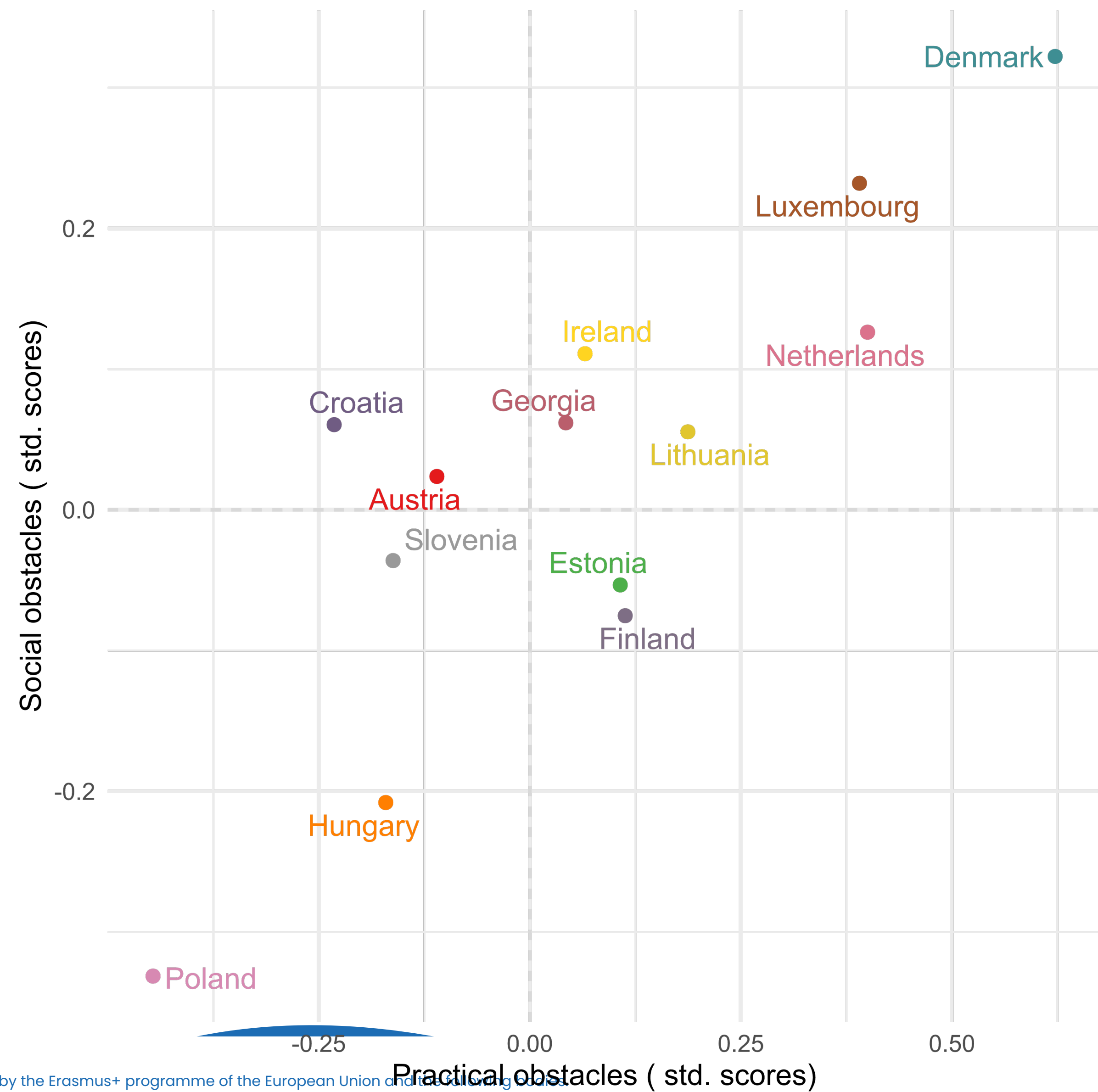

Factor scores: distribution for countries



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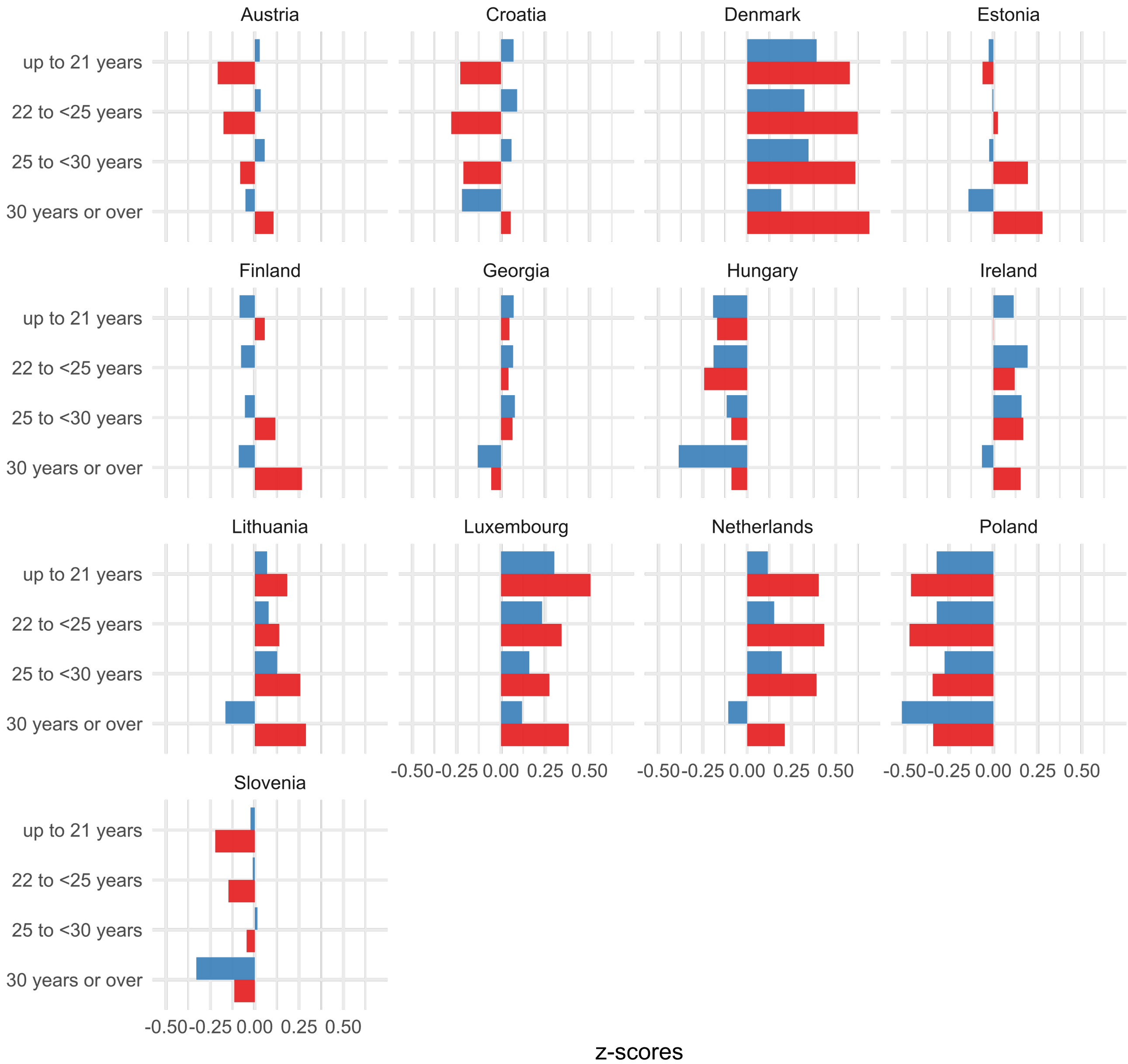
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Factor scores: distribution for age groups within countries



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Example 2: Students' social integration

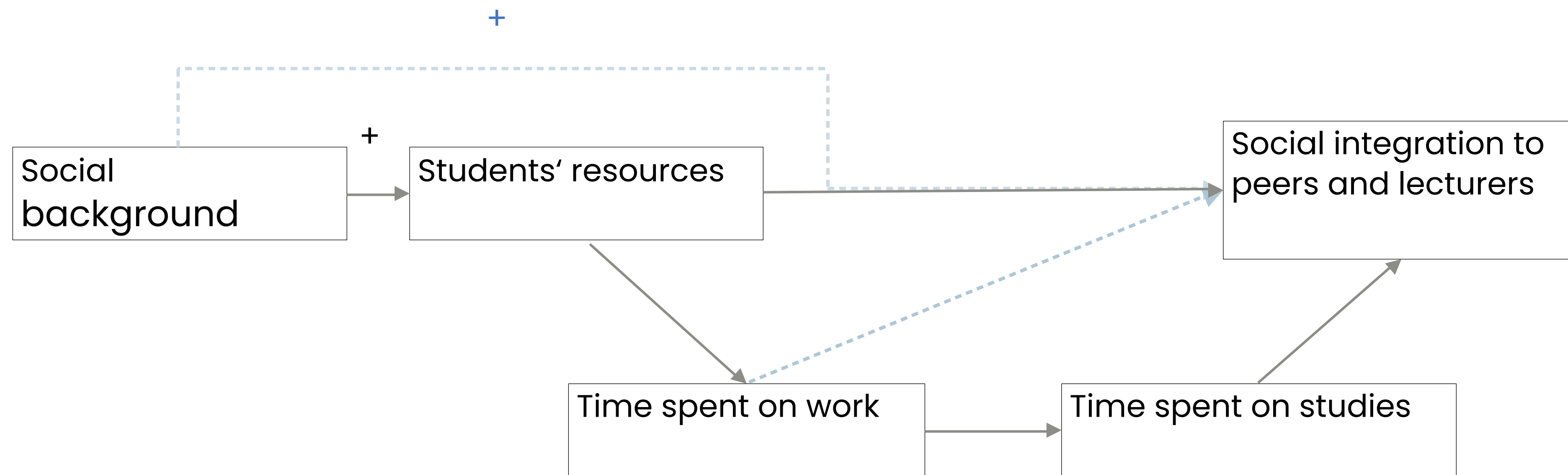
Research questions

- Which factors contribute to students' social integration at higher education institutions?
- How does this vary over different countries and can it be mitigated by dependency on student grants?

Theoretical framework

- Tinto's model of socio-academic integration (1975) and its adaptations (e.g. Bean et al. 1985; Deil-Amen 2012)
- Focus on social (not academic) integration of students, concerning a) their peers b) lecturers.





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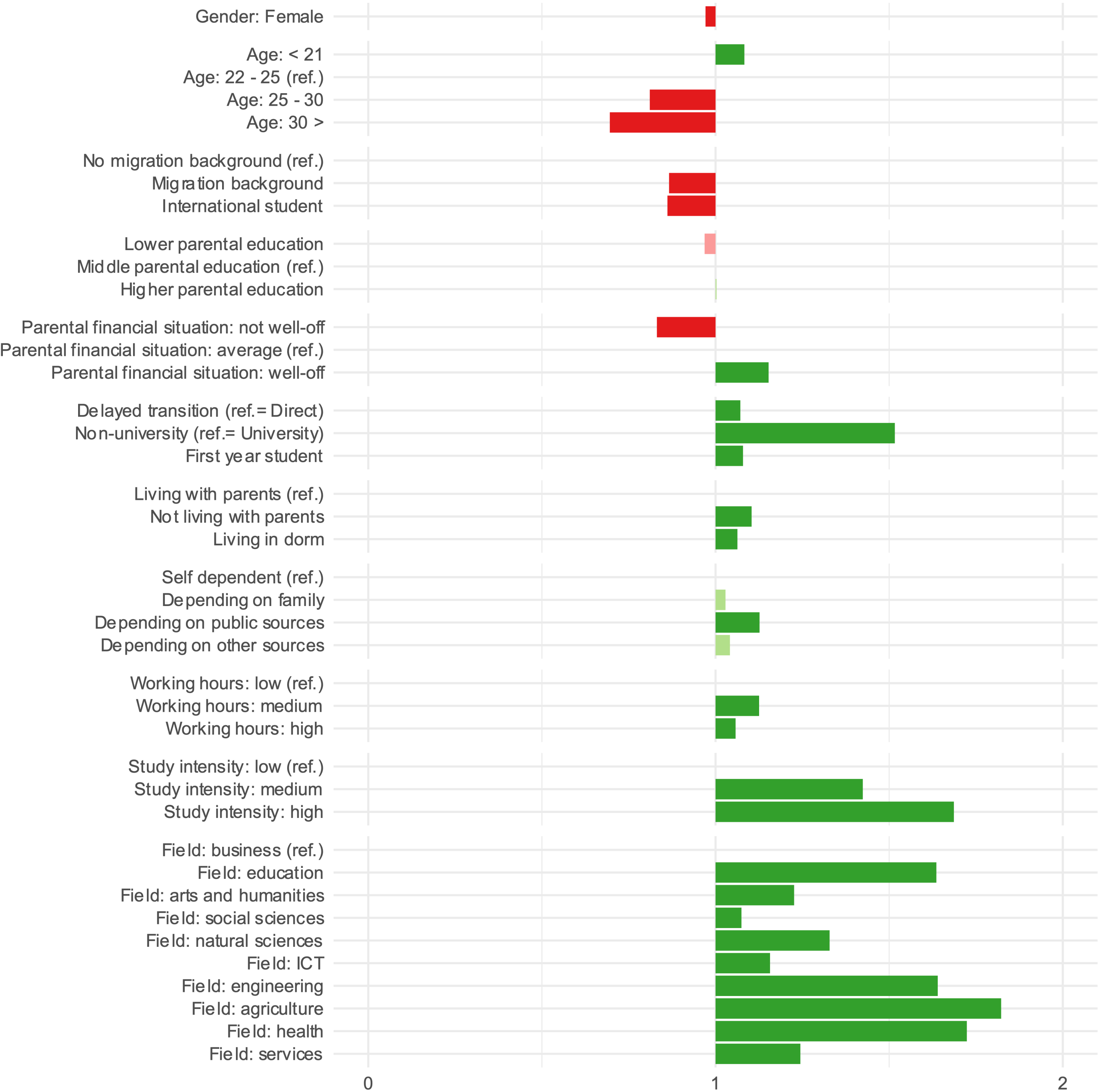


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Results: students' social integration with fellow students



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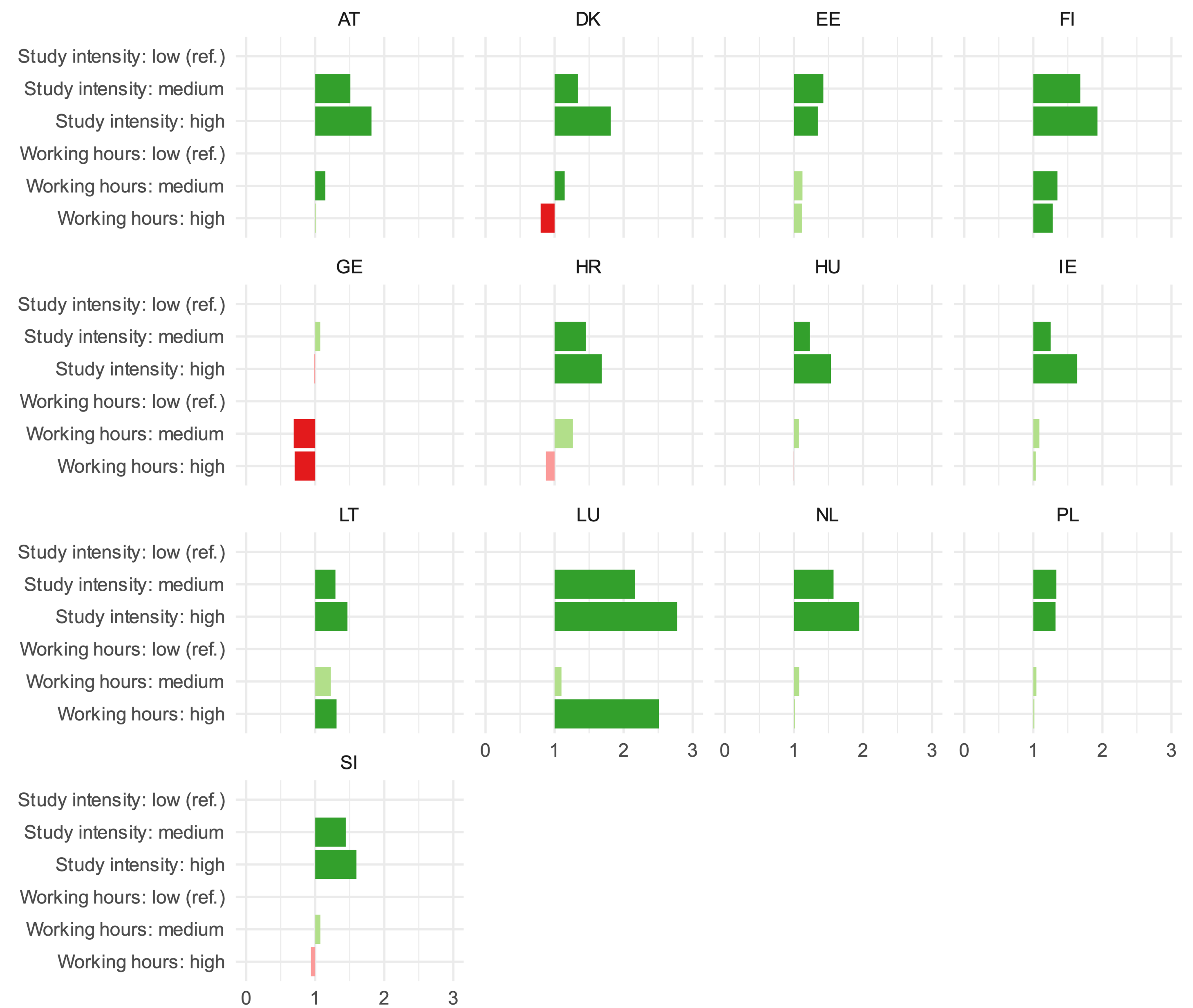
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Results: Effects of study time and working time



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Results: Effects of Social economic background



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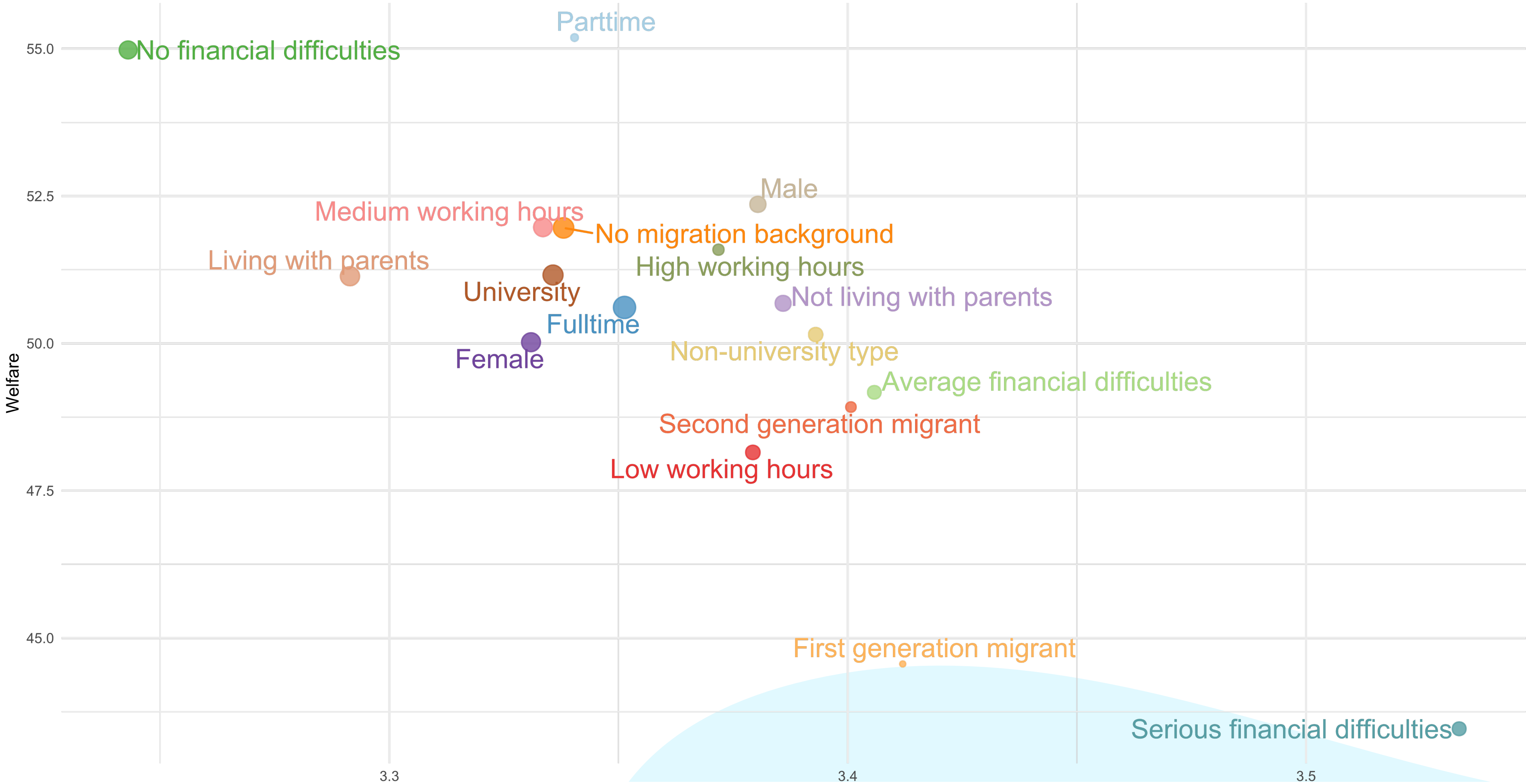
