TARGET GROUP

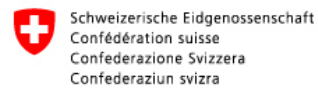

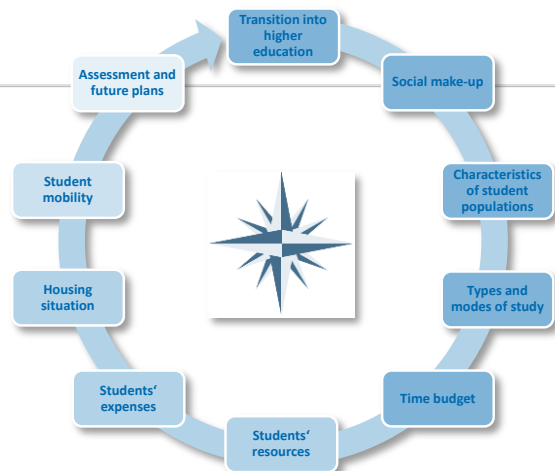

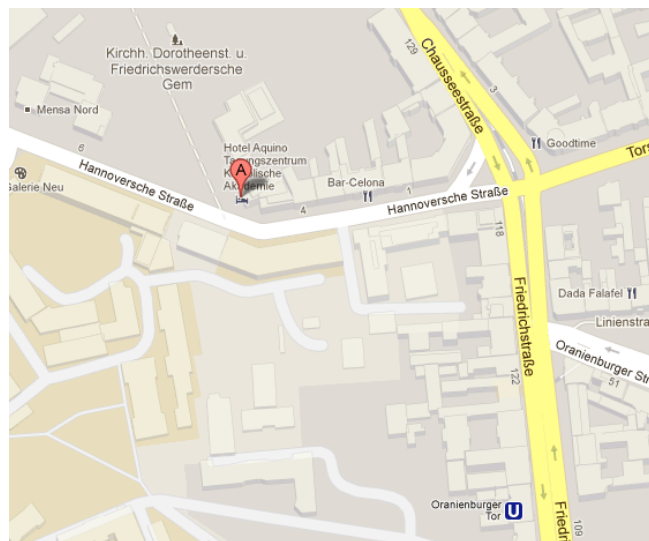
